



Student Acceptable Use Agreement for iPads/Computers

Learning is an ongoing interaction between students, teachers, administrators, and parents. Using iPads/computers within education can help augment the curriculum while allowing students to better learn and comprehend the material. The policies, procedures and information within this document apply to all iPads/computers used in school. Teachers and administrators may set additional requirements for use in their classroom.

Students must abide by all school rules as outlined in the Student Handbook, Acceptable Use Policy, and Expectations of Using Tablets for Readers.

Acceptable Use

The use of technology resources is a privilege, not a right. This acceptable use agreement is provided to make both students and educators aware of the responsibilities associated with efficient, ethical, and lawful use of technology resources. If you violate any of the User Terms and Conditions named in this policy, privileges may be terminated and disciplinary action could be applied. Your school's Student Code of Conduct shall be applied to student infractions. When applicable, law enforcement agencies may be involved.

Students are responsible for:

- Using iPads/computers in a responsible and ethical manner.
- Obeying general school rules concerning behavior and communication that apply to iPad/computer use.
- Using all technology resources in an appropriate manner so as to not damage school equipment. This "damage" includes, but is not limited to, the loss of data resulting from delays, non-deliveries, mis-deliveries or service interruptions caused by the students own negligence, errors or omissions.
- Complying with trademark and copyright laws and all license agreements. Ignorance of the law is not immunity. If you are unsure, ask a teacher or parent.

Network Connectivity

Students are only allowed to access the school's network with the permission of the school principal, technology teacher, and the classroom teacher. If this is done without this permission, the students will face discipline actions deemed appropriate by the administration.

Sound, Music, Games, or Apps

Sound must be muted at all times unless permission is obtained from the teacher for instructional purposes. Music is allowed on the iPads/computers and can be used at the discretion of the teacher and district policies. Games are not allowed to be played on the iPads/computers during the school day. Apps can be used at the discretion of the teacher. These apps need to be directly related to the curriculum.

Screensavers/Background Photos

Inappropriate media may not be used as a screensaver or background photo. Presence of guns, weapons, inappropriate photos and/or language, alcohol, drug, and gang related symbols or pictures will result in disciplinary actions.

Student Activities Strictly Prohibited While in School

- Illegal installation or transmission of copyrighted materials
- Any action that violates existing school policy or public law
- Sending, accessing, uploading, downloading, or distributing offensive, profane, threatening, obscene, or inappropriate materials
- Internet/Computer Games
- Spamming-Sending mass or inappropriate emails
- Gaining access to other student's or teacher's accounts, files, and/or data
- Vandalism (any malicious attempt to harm or destroy hardware, software or data, including, but not limited to, the uploading or creation of computer viruses or computer programs that can infiltrate computer systems and/or damage software components) of school equipment will not be allowed
- Transmission or accessing materials that are obscene, offensive, threatening or otherwise intended to harass or demean recipients.
- Violation of applicable state or federal law will result in criminal prosecution or disciplinary action by the school district.

Student Pledge for iPads/Computers Use

- I will use my iPad/computer in ways that are appropriate, meet school expectations and are educational.
 - Always have clean hands.
 - Use two hands when carrying an iPad/computer.
 - Put the iPad/computer in my lap when opening my desk.
 - Not put the iPad/computer on the floor unless my teacher tells me to.
 - Use the iPad/computer gently.
- I will follow the policies outlined in school's guidelines while at school.
 - No liquids around the iPad/computer. EVER!
 - Always know where my iPad/computer is.
 - Have an adult plug my iPad/computer in when I see the battery is low.
 - Use the apps and programs my teacher has instructed me to use.
 - Be on task, using the iPad/computer as instructed by the teacher.
 - Be responsible and make smart learning choices while using my iPad/computer.
 - I will ask other people before taking their picture.
- I understand and agree to the stipulations set forth in the document above and understand that I will lose the privilege of the iPad/computer for the rest of the day (minimum) if I do not follow these rules.
