

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Hi! My name is Page Eberhardt and I will be your child's teacher this year. I hope they are looking forward to the year to come as much as I am. This is my seventh year as the preschool and Pre-K teacher, and I love every minute of it! I thought I would let you know a little bit about what my class looks like.

8:10: Morning gathering for Pledge of Allegiance, prayer, song and any announcements

8:25 - 8:50: Free play and then morning cleanup

8:50 - 9:15: Circle time (includes calendar, weather, concepts to learn)

9:15 - 9:30: Math

9:30 - 9:45: Religion/Science

9:45 - 10:00: Recess (all children go outside unless sick)

10:00- 10:15: Snacks*

10:15-11:00: Centers (literacy, fine motor, manipulatives, art)

11:00 -11:15: Story time and the prepare to leave or go to lunch

*Snacks are a great part of our morning and provided by the parents. At the beginning of every month I will send home a calendar with your students scheduled snack day. You may bring it in whenever you wish, or send it with your child on their day. Please no drinks and items must be store bought. Also, anything you bring in can be recorded on your volunteer log sheet. Every \$15 equals 1 volunteer hour. I would love for snacks to reinforce our color, shape, number or letter that we are learning that week whenever possible. I will provide a list of snack ideas!

We will have show and tell every Thursday/Friday, but I in my class students bring in something that goes with the letter or color we learned about that week. We will be starting this the second week of school.

I love to celebrate birthdays. I will schedule your child's snack day on or near their birthday. For summer birthday's I will let you know when we celebrate (July and August probably in September/October and June in May). Please let me know if you plan on bringing in a special treat that day (these snack days to not have to reinforce unless you are feeling really

creative!).

Please have a spare set of clothes in your child's backpack (especially for the first couple weeks of school). Accidents do happen and it's easier on everybody if they have their own things to change into.

All correspondence will be posted on the school website. That includes notes from the school, the lunch menu, as well as notes that I would normally send home. If you have not done so already, please register at <http://www.stnicholasrupert.org>. Please check it weekly for updates. The home page will have the school news and upcoming events. My classroom page will have any other information that pertains to my class (be sure to check under classroom documents in the right hand corner too). If you do not have access to the website, please let me know so I can send home physical notes with your child!

If your child will be absent, please remember to call the school. Or, send me an email/text. If we know your child is absent, it saves a phone call verifying where your child is (unless of course that is your preference!)
